# EasyJet Baggage Allowance

- Each passenger is entitled to check a bag that is up to 15kg – each additional kilo will cost (£15)
- You can take one piece of hand baggage (10kg) into the cabin with you - no bigger than 56 x 45 x 25cm incl wheels
- Liquid is in a container with a maximum volume of <u>100ml</u>
- All containers must comfortably fit into a transparent, re-sealable 1 litre plastic bag, measuring no more than 20 x 20cm
- This plastic bag must be removed from the hand baggage and shown separately to airport security

# Safety at the Hotel

- Students are NOT to leave hotel unless supervised by a teacher.
- Students must NOT use the fire doors unless there is a fire.

# **Expected Behaviour**

- All students must be respectful at <u>all times</u>
- Must follow instructions from both teaching staff, guides and hotel staff
- Do not enter other peoples rooms (meet up with friends in the common room)
- Remember this is your trip so support each other and enjoy this wonderful opportunity.

# **Evening Activities**

- Common room at hotel for people to relax.
- Range of games will be played.
- Pupils can use the pool (when a member of staff is present)

# **Important Points**

- Pupils must be able to carry their own bags
- All meals in Iceland are provided. However we recommend that pupils take £50.00 (Icelandic Kronor) + £20.00 in cash in case they wish to buy something to eat on the way to/back from the airport. (<u>Suggested</u>)
- Bring a suitable day bag/rucksack to store essentials (hats, gloves, wallets, etc) during the day trips

# **Important Points**

- Mobile phones/MP3 players NOT insured
- Remember chargers and European adapters if you bring them at own risk
- Mobile phone charges abroad can be costly.....check your provider for costs
- Some phones may not be set up for 'roaming' and if used may incur a charge.
- Switch off internet access it could cost you a large amount upon your return.

# **Important Points**

Be prepared for Icelandic food!

 Inform staff of dietary needs/vegetarians before you leave this evening

# Health and Passports

- Pre-existing health conditions covered for any student under 16yrs old
- All those that are over 16 have provided copies of medical declaration - if changes before travelling please inform Travellers Health Check again)
- Requested passports and EHIC to be handed in to school the Monday (3<sup>rd</sup> December) before we depart
- All medicines to be packed in suitcase in a clearly labelled bag.
- If any medicine needs to be taken on board the plane, a member of staff needs to be made aware beforehand.
- Travel sickness tablets to be taken prior to boarding and clearly labelled with pupil's name
- Girls are advised to bring sanitary products (just in case)
- All children should have an individual EHIC European Health Card

# Passport information

 Can we have all the EHIC and passport information before December 3<sup>rd</sup>

 Need to make sure your passport has 6 months on it after February!! Average temperature is - 2C in February with night temperature falling to around - 4C or more.

- Ski Jacket and trousers or something similar
- Waterproof/wind proof trousers
- Thermals
- Hat, scarf and gloves
- Thin layers
- Walking boots/shoes/ snow boots (eBay)
- Thick walking socks (3 pairs)
- Suntan lotion and lip seal
- A rucksack
- Towel (carry wet towel home)
- Swimsuit/swim shorts

When wrapped up appropriately you will not feel the cold but remember you are out all day every day so wear layers. You can take them off and put them into your bag.

#### **Iceland Kit List**



#### Hand luggage

This should be packed in the rucksack that you will be using as your day bag during the visit

- Waterproof jacket a wind and rainproof coat is ideal
- Gloves, Scarf and Warm Hat please ensure your hat covers your ears
- Personal medication eg inhalers. If you carry epipens or insulin, you must have a recent doctor's
- Swim suit if you are visiting the Blue Lagoon before checking in at the accommodation. Towel hire is not included as standard, therefore you may need to also include a towel. Towels can be hired for €5 each.
- Currency Sterling and Icelandic Krona
- Camera/Phone/iPod
- ☐ Sweets/snacks
- ☐ Tour documents itinerary, boarding pass and flight information, emergency contact numbers and a notepad with
- ☐ EHIC Healthcard
- ☐ Travel Insurance Documents

- $\Box$ Do not pack any sharp items in your hand luggage eg. tweezers, scissors, razor blade
- All liquids, pastes and gels (includes make-up) must be in containers of no more than 100ml and placed in a clear plastic bag to go through security.

- Sturdy walking shoes hiking boots are ideal as you may walk on slippery/loose ground
- ☐ Thick, warm socks
- Long sleeved jumpers/fleeces
- Waterproof overtrousers sports style trousers are suitable
- Long johns, tights or leggings two bottom layers can be necessary to keep warm ■ Warm trousers to wear over your base layer
- Toiletries including moisturiser and lip balm (to protect your skin against the wind)
- Northern European 2 pin travel adaptor
- ☐ Hair dryer
- ☐ Sunglasses and sunscreen it can be very sunny

There is limited availability of Icelandic Krona (ISK) so you need to order it at least two weeks in advance. The exchange rate is currently approx. 1500kr = £10

Debit cards are widely accepted in Iceland
