Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very proud of our Sixth Form students and recognise that they are the senior students in the school and as such we do not expect them to wear school uniform. However, we do expect students to adopt a “smart casual” mode of dress, which is appropriate for school and thus makes them role models for younger students. When students return in September there will be a dictated notice board of our uniform expectations to illustrate and clarify the dress code.

The Sixth Form uniform guidelines are below:

Students must wear “smart casual” dress. This does not include ripped jeans, crop tops, spaghetti strap tops, “Bardot top” or hair dyed in extreme colours.

Skirts are acceptable throughout the year but must be of an appropriate length that conveys the professionalism we expect from Bewdley Sixth Form students.

Shorts are only acceptable in the summer term (starting after the Easter holidays.)

Tops with offensive messages on are not acceptable.

If Sixth Form students attend inappropriately dressed you will receive a letter after a discussion has taken place with the student which reminds students of our dress code and the subsequent sanctions. If there is a repeat offence the student will be sent home or if this is not possible, placed in isolation for the day.

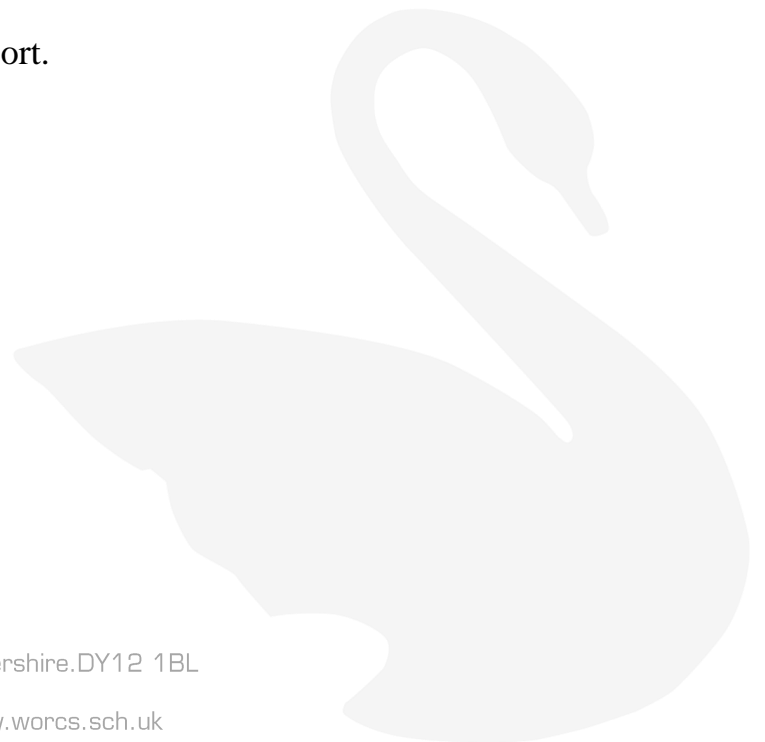
