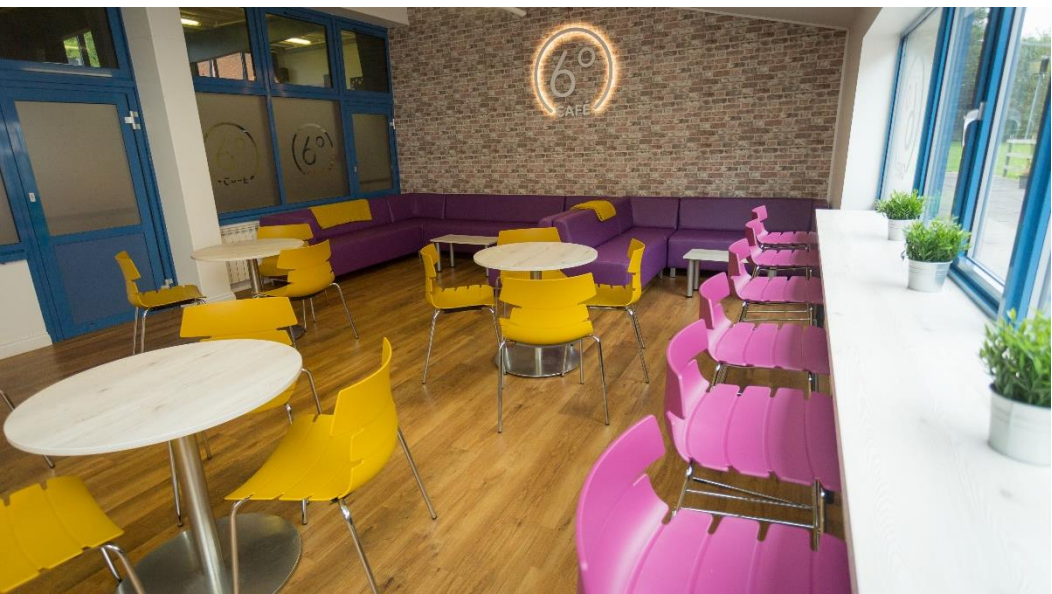

Bewdley Sixth Form is also partnered with the University of Birmingham



- This means that some our students, may be eligible to apply to one of several pathways on offer:
- Inspired@Birmingham - Supports Year 12 students who are interested in applying to Russell Group universities - learn from our student mentors, graduates and academics
- Routes to the Professions - A unique opportunity for Year 12 students to gain a real insight into university study and specific careers over an 18-month programme of activity
- Academic Enrichment Programme - An immersive five-day residential for Year 12 students in the Greater West Midlands region, giving students an insight into the full university experience



An example of the support we give

- One student has applied to Veterinary Medical school
- There are only 8 universities in country which offer this course and there are **14** applications for **1** place. We:
- Provided careers advice from September of Year 12
- Health and Safety Assessed suitable work placements
- Arranged for work missed during these placements to be caught up
- Supported the initial application process by providing advice on personal statements
- Found free online courses to provide insight into his course
- Undertook 4 mock interviews
- Supported the student through the 3 additional examinations to be completed before interview.
- Provided outstanding extra and super curricular opportunities to help build the skills needed such as the Gold Crest Award

A Further Example – Business and Accounting



- A student was unsure about whether University or an apprenticeship was the right route for them. We:
- Organised for HSBC to give a bespoke talk about their apprenticeships
- Found university taster days
- Organised for students to take part in an accountancy competition
- Helped him complete an EPQ to prepare his extended writing skills
- Personalised help to fill in UCAS application
- Mock interviews for apprenticeships
