As this term comes to an end, it is a chance to reflect on a long and busy few months for the school and a year that has to be the most difficult in terms of having some stability and normal schooling pattern. - All students have had an assembly on 'peer on peer' abuse What is it?
- Nationwide Building Society working with the school to develop a bespoke financial literacy programme for the students
- Careers fair for Year 10 13 students over 40 exhibitors!
- Elevate education independent study workshops for Year 11 students
- Relationship and sex education now being delivered on a rolling programme to all Year 7 & 8 students throughout the year
- A Wellbeing and Emotional Support Practitioner (on behalf of Public Health England) has been allocated to the school and will be working in school for 2.5 days per week after the Christmas break.

High Expectations of Uniform

We expect all students to be smart because we are a school with traditional values. The expectation is that all students are in full school uniform every day. 
