Pre-1900 Poetry:

- Create a leaflet about your pre-1900 poets. <u>ONE</u> page per poet, which must be presented in a creative and appealing way as it will be colour photocopied and given to prospective Year 12s at our 6th form Open Evening in October.
- Each page must include: an image of the poet, dates born and died, a summary of why they are a famous poet, which King or Queen was on the throne during their lifetime, whether they are a restoration poet, a metaphysical poet, lyrical poet, cavalier poet, Victorian realist, writing within the decadent movement or the romantic movement and a brief summary of what that means / how it influenced their poetry.
- Poets to cover: Thomas Wyatt, William Shakespeare, John Donne, Andrew Marvell, Richard Lovelace, John Wilmot, William Blake, Robert Burns, Lord Byron, Christina Rossetti, Thomas Hardy, John Keats and Ernest Dowson.
