

# KS5 Summer Preparation Task: Presentation on a Music Industry Professional

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In preparation for Unit 349: Planning for a Career in the Music Industry, you must research and create a PowerPoint presentation on a well-known person from a music industry career that interests you. This could be a performer, producer, sound engineer, music manager, journalist, promoter, label executive, or any other professional role within the industry.

## **Your PowerPoint should include:**

### **1. Introduction to the Person**

- Full name and job title(s)
- Brief biography (background, upbringing, education, key influences)

### **2. Career Journey**

- How they got started in the industry
- Key milestones and achievements
- Career progression or role changes

### **3. Skills and Qualities**

- Technical skills and soft skills (e.g., resilience, networking)
- Any formal training or relevant experience

### **4. Challenges and Resilience**

- Key setbacks they've faced
- How they overcame them and what this shows about industry realities

### **5. Industry Impact**

- Their contribution to music or the wider industry
- Awards, recognitions, trends, or influence on others

### **6. Industry Insight**

- What their job involves day-to-day
- Working patterns (freelance, employed, touring, etc.)
- Typical challenges or expectations in this career path

### **7. References and Research Sources**

- Books, articles, interviews, videos, or websites you used

## **Reflective Task: Learning From Their Journey**

Add a final slide reflecting on what you've learned and how it applies to you. Answer the following:

- What key skills or attitudes helped this person succeed?
- Which of those do you already have?
- What do you still need to work on?
- How can you follow a similar path or adapt their approach to suit your goals?

## **Guidelines on Using AI Tools (e.g., ChatGPT, Perplexity, Claude)**

You are allowed to use AI tools to help with research or generating ideas. However:

- You must include a link or copy of the AI-generated chat or content you used.
- Make sure you fact-check any information taken from AI.
- Do not copy text directly into your slides without editing it in your own words.

This is part of showing that you can use digital tools responsibly and critically — an important skill in the creative industries.

## **Presentation Format**

- 8–10 slides (use images, quotes, video/audio clips if you like)
- Be ready to give a 5-minute overview presentation in the first week of term
